RULES, TERMS & CONDITIONS

Enter at your own risk. We are not responsible or liable for any personal injury due to slips, falls, cuts, pokes, scratches, etc. You assume all risk of personal injury while on the premises or while inspecting auction vehicles. Be aware many vehicles have broken glass, exposed sharp metal edges, hypodermic needles, razors and/or other potential hazards.

No children under the age of 15 are allowed in the storage yard. Children 15 & above must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian. The parent or legal guardian must assume all responsibility for the minor. Minors are not permitted to bid.

Anyone who wishes to enter the storage yard to view or bid on vehicles must sign in with picture id, and agree to these rules, terms and conditions. Each individual signing in will be issued an identifying number. The number must be visible at all times.

Do not remove any items from the vehicles. This is considered theft. The police will be called and we will press charges. Any person caught stealing items from vehicles will be banned from attending any future auctions. We have a zero tolerance policy on theft.

Stay in the auction area. Do not enter restricted areas. Do not touch or inspect vehicles that are not included in the auction.

All vehicles are sold as is, where is. All sales are final. The vehicle will need to be towed out, pushed out, or driven out of the yard, we cannot allow mechanical repairs to be done in the storage yard.

Payment is required by the end of the day, unless other arrangements have been made. We accept cash or credit card payments. Violation of the payment policy results in forfeiture of your bid and suspension or banishment from future auctions.

Sales tax will be charged on all sales unless a sellers resale certificate is on file.

Vehicles must be removed within 48 hours, unless prior arrangements have been made. Violation of this policy will result in forfeiture of your bid and suspension or banishment from future auctions.

In the case the highest bidder defaults (or otherwise forfeits his/her bid) the next bidder has the right to purchase the vehicle for the amount of his/her bid.

The successful bidder must apply for title within fifteen days unless provided otherwise by law. RCW 46.55.130 (2f).

We can refuse to accept a bid for any reason posted in our rules, terms & conditions, and for any of the following reasons: (a) The bidder is currently indebted to the operator; (b) the operator has knowledge that the bidder has previously abandoned vehicles purchased at auction; or (c) the bidder has purchased, at auction, more than four vehicles in the last calendar year without obtaining title to any or all of the vehicles. RCW 46.55.130 (3)
